'CBSE - One Child, One Plant Campaign' Report



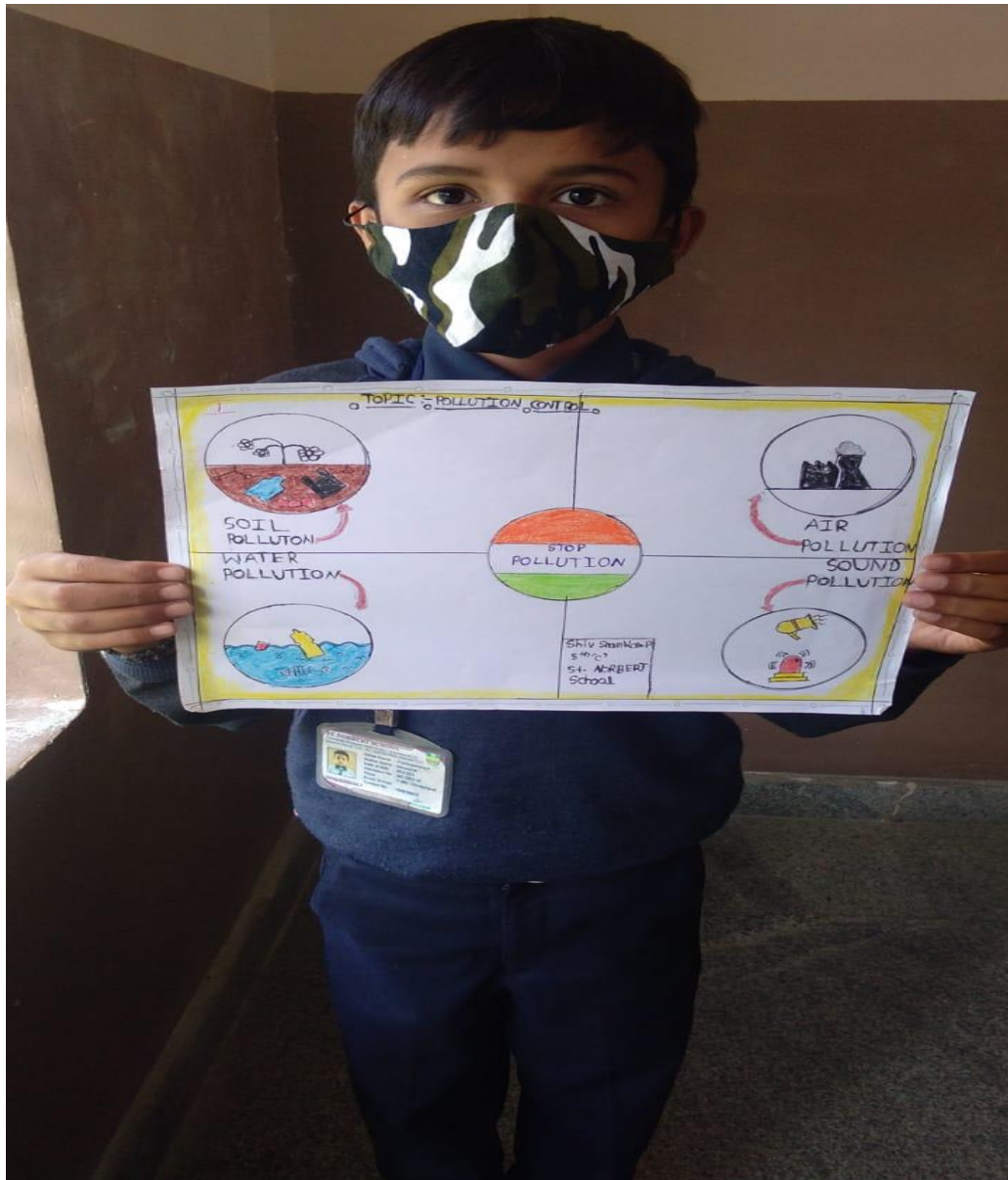
Activity: 1

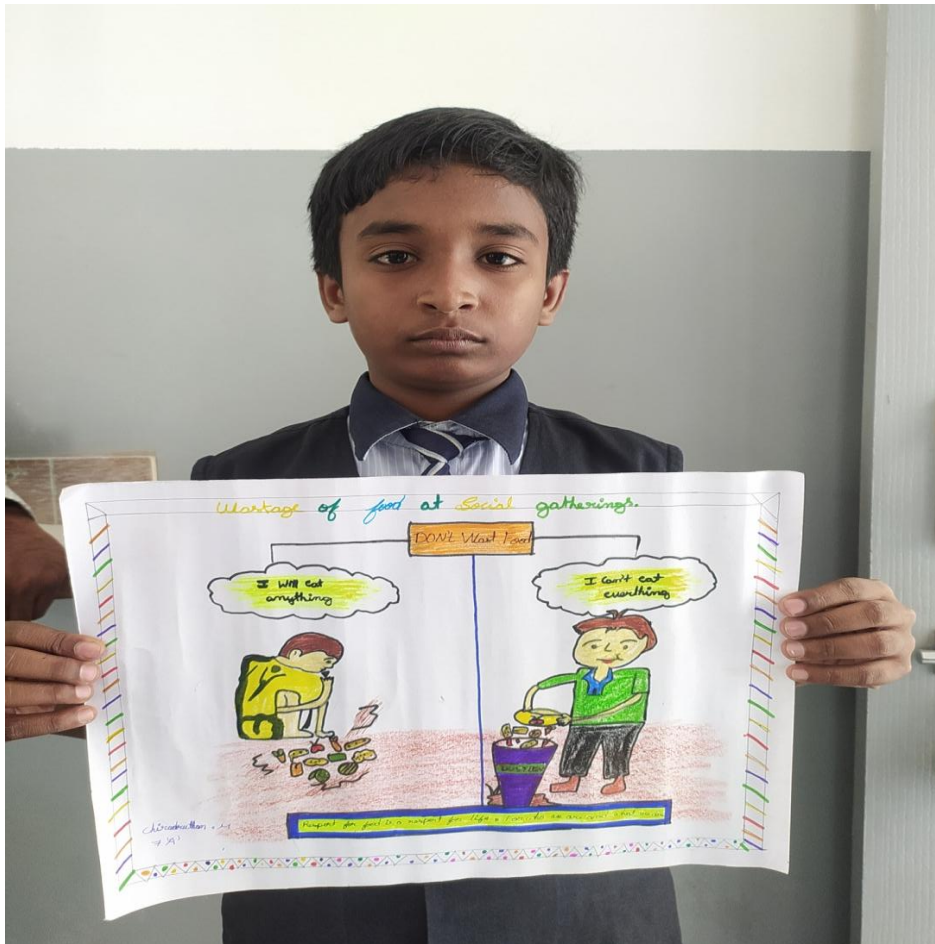




Activity: 3

Essay Writing Competition

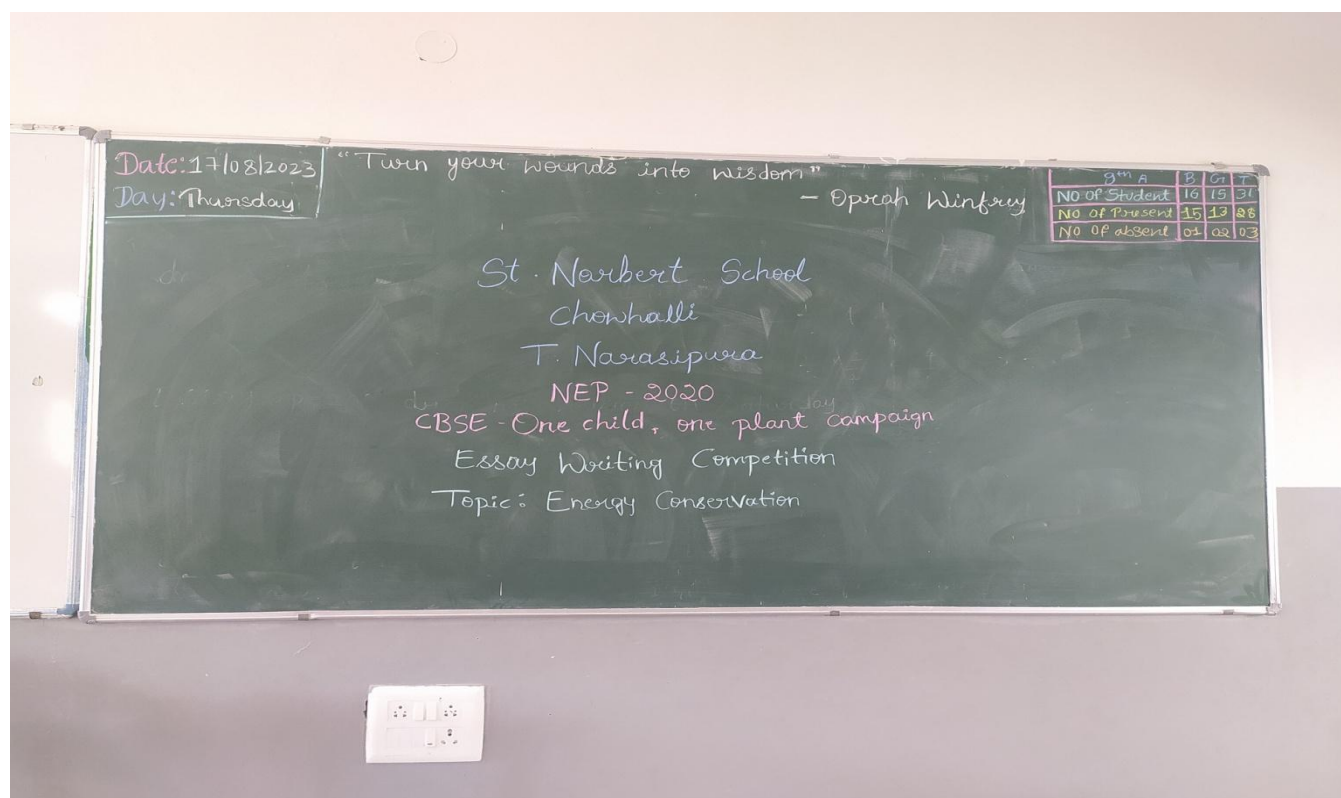
