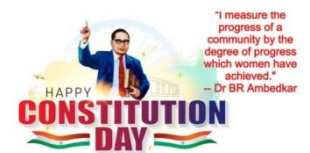


Every activity in school life, plays a significant role in a child's development. Co-curricular activities are an essential part of school life as they help to enhance the learning process of the students.
