

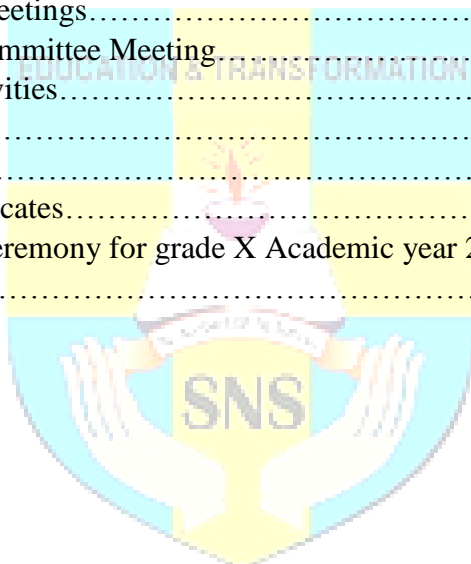

7. Online and offline classes:

The Covid-19 pandemic has forced the educators to transform their lessons to online version in short span of time. Our teachers had to change online teaching mode and requested them to use various digital tools and resources and implemented new approaches to teaching and learning process. Education is the process of different skill building that should be interacting and innovative so that various skills can be improved by reading, writing, learning, listening and speaking. During the pandemic, we have understood the importance of teaching and learning. Many of our students expressed that the offline classes are more beneficial and more productive as compared to any other mode of education. It is a direct interaction between the Teacher and students. During the lock down St. Norbert school has taken maximum care in educating the children and providing the best possibilities.

With the permission of the Karnataka government, we conducted offline classes for the grades 6 to 10 from August and 1 to 5 from September. The offline classes gave teachers as well as students the ample of opportunities to learn and to interact with each other.

8. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

We began academic year for grades 9&10 in May 2021 and for grades 6 and above from June and the other lower grades from July. The academic year comprised of two terms, which had four periodic assessments and two term exams. The day at school begins with the assembly at 9.15 am and is conducted by different classes in turn. Classes during this year were divided into seven periods beginning from 9.30 am to 3.45 pm

On 28 February, 2022 we conducted Term-2 exam for the grades 8 and 9. After declaring the results of grades 8 and 9, students were promoted to grade 9 and 10 and we began their classes from 21 March, 2022. With the gratitude to God and his assistance from 24 March 2022, annual examination was conducted for the grades KG to 7 and children were promoted to the next level of learning.

9. Investiture ceremony:

Our school office bearers were officially sworn in a very impressive investiture ceremony on 7 August, 2021. The school cabinet was led by our Head boy Mr. Drushya and Head Girl Ms. Hemashree. 10. School Newsletter “Campus Chronicle”

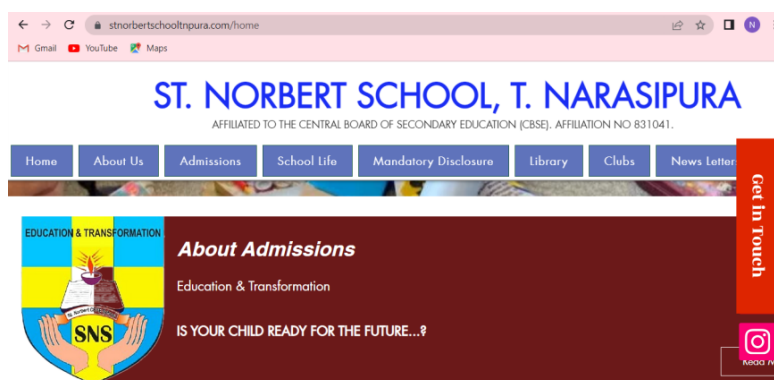

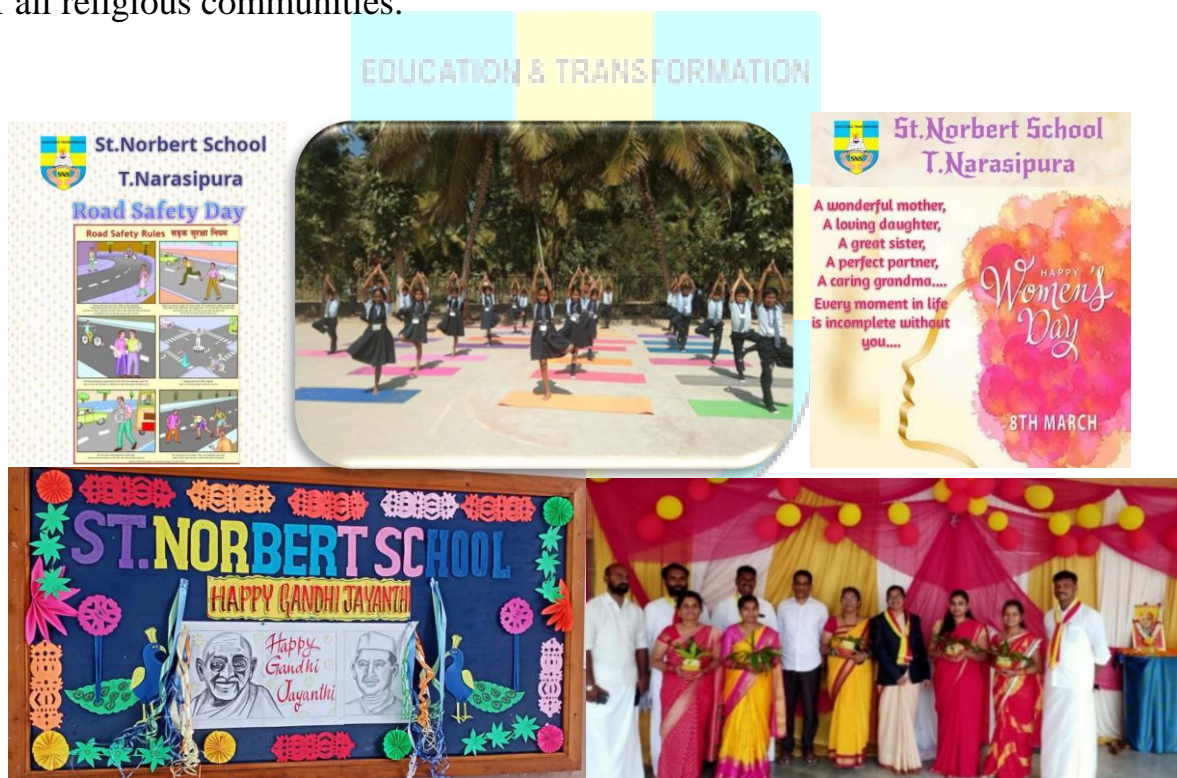
